Guidelines for Building Use

The buildings and grounds of the Gowensville Community Center are intended for the use of community residents in accordance with the bylaws of the Greater Gowensville Association (GGA). Anyone requesting use of the center should have a community connection.

Authorized usage of the buildings and grounds include the following types of activities.

1. GGA meetings and activities
2. Community projects such as
 - Elections and precinct meetings
 - Fall Festival and associated craft activities
 - Church or other community group-sponsored activities
3. Private use, as approved:
 - Family reunions
 - Family parties
4. Agricultural and home extension meetings
5. Youth activities; must be supervised by a member of the GGA or an approved adult
6. Commercial activities are not permitted by GGA by laws except as part of Fall Festival activities or other GGA-sponsored events.
7. Benefits **MUST** be sponsored by a church or an organized service or non-profit group which accepts the responsibility to ensure that funds are given to the person or group for whom the benefit is conducted.

The building coordinator and/or the GGA Board of Trustees will resolve any questionable usage of the buildings or grounds.
